

## REGIONALLY IMPORTANT PROJECTS

As part of the Regional Futures Plan, the Regional Investment Evaluation Process provides a systematic approach to identifying and securing support for Regionally Important Projects.

The Regional Economic Development Committee will maintain a list of regionally important projects, which will be reviewed and published quarterly.

The first list was released in early 2020 and is constantly updated. The purpose of the list is for our region to speak with one voice in support of projects that will drive positive economic change.

### Current endorsed projects:

- Don River Railway Expansion – The project's vision is to transform the Don River Railway into a key attraction for heritage tourism in Tasmania. This initiative will introduce new rail journeys, revitalise the Don River Railway Depot, and expand its offerings to attract more visitors.
- Cradle Mountain Visitor Experience Master Plan (CMVEMP) – The Office of the Coordinator-General is seeking a commitment from the Federal Government for an 80-20 funding split with the Tasmanian Government to fully implement this project.
- West Coast Renewable Energy (WRE) - Whaleback Ridge – WRE proposes to construct a wind farm off the west coast of Tasmania that will generate up to 3GW of electricity.
- HIF Tasmania eFuels Facility – HIF Tasmania will be the first commercial scale e-Fuels facility to be built in Australia.
